



## Do-It-Yourself Bucket Information

This is a great option for cutting costs and adding a creative element to your celebration.

The flowers provided in bulk buckets are seasonal varieties available from our fields at the time of your wedding. We curate our buckets carefully to make them fun to design with. We'll provide you with as much beauty and variety as possible. Flowers are bundled in groups of 5's and are growers choice. If you have specific requests such as color and type of flower they will need to be reviewed individually for additional cost. Of course, the more buckets you order the more variety we can include. Following is a list of the type of combinations you can expect.

**Focal Flowers** - The large, eye-catching central flowers such as Dahlias, Zinnias, Sunflowers, Lilies.

**Secondary Flowers** - These flowers are secondary to your focals and might include Lisianthus, Sweet William, Sweet Peas, Cosmos, Dara, Rudbeckia, Celosia, Amaranth, Poppies.

**Line Flowers**- These flowers have a straight, single stem habits and are used to create direction. They include Snapdragon, Foxglove, Lupin, Larkspur, Gladiolus, Stock, Bells of Ireland.

**Filler Flowers**- These flowers have a central stem with many side stems, umbrells or breaks. They are most often used to fill space and create form within your designs. They include flowers such as Statice, Matricaria, Achillia, Queen Anne's Lace, Phlox, Asters, Nigella.

**Greenery**- These stems are the foliage used to take your designs to the next level. Some of our favorites are locally foraged bayberry, blueberry, willow, rose foliage, blackberry and raspberry canes, basil, mint, scented geraniums.

*Textures*-These are the extra pieces that really heighten your designs. They include seasonal grains and grasses that come in many hues, such as bronze, silver-grey, golden-brown and lush greens.

## *How many vases or bouquets will my bucket of flowers make?*

Of course this depends on you and the style of your pieces but as a guideline we recommend one bucket per three bouquets. If you have a few sprigs left over they can be used as cake flowers or added to table arrangements. When creating table arrangements the size of the vessel makes a big difference. We estimate that with one bucket you will be able to make:

- 15-20 Bud Vases - containing 1-3 stems per vessel*
- 5-8 (500ml) Mason Jars - containing 8-10 stems per vessel*
- 4 (750 ml) Large Mason Jars - containing 10-12 stems per vessel*

We hope you'll enjoy making your designs and remember keep it fun and let the flowers do the work!
